

NYU School of Professional Studies Online Language Proficiency Testing

Undergraduate students fluent in a language other than English may consider taking an NYU Online Language Proficiency test to earn credit towards their degree. Before testing, students should contact their faculty advisor or Evaluations to confirm language credit will be applicable to their major.

Testing Process

Online proficiency exams are conducted throughout the year. You will need the following to complete the test: High speed internet connection, Laptop/computer device with a camera, speakers and a microphone; Modern web browser: Firefox (only the latest version of Firefox is fully compatible with the exam). Fees

NYU charges \$579 for the 12-Point exam, plus a registration fee
Additionally, there is an hourly proctoring fee paid directly to the remote proctoring vendor of \$25.00 for the first hour of the exam, and \$13.50 for every additional hour, thereafter.
New York Tech charges \$175 per course (2025-26) to award proficiency exam credit

Credit Awards

- A maximum of nine (9) Proficiency Exam credits may be earned for an NYU Language Proficiency exam.
- Credit will be awarded based on points scored on the exam.
- Only credit applicable to a student’s undergraduate degree program will be awarded.
